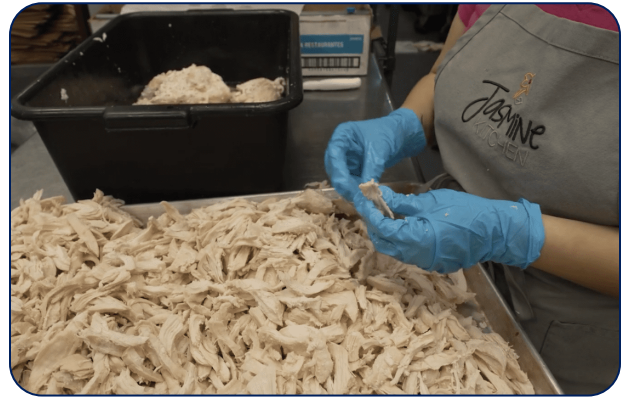

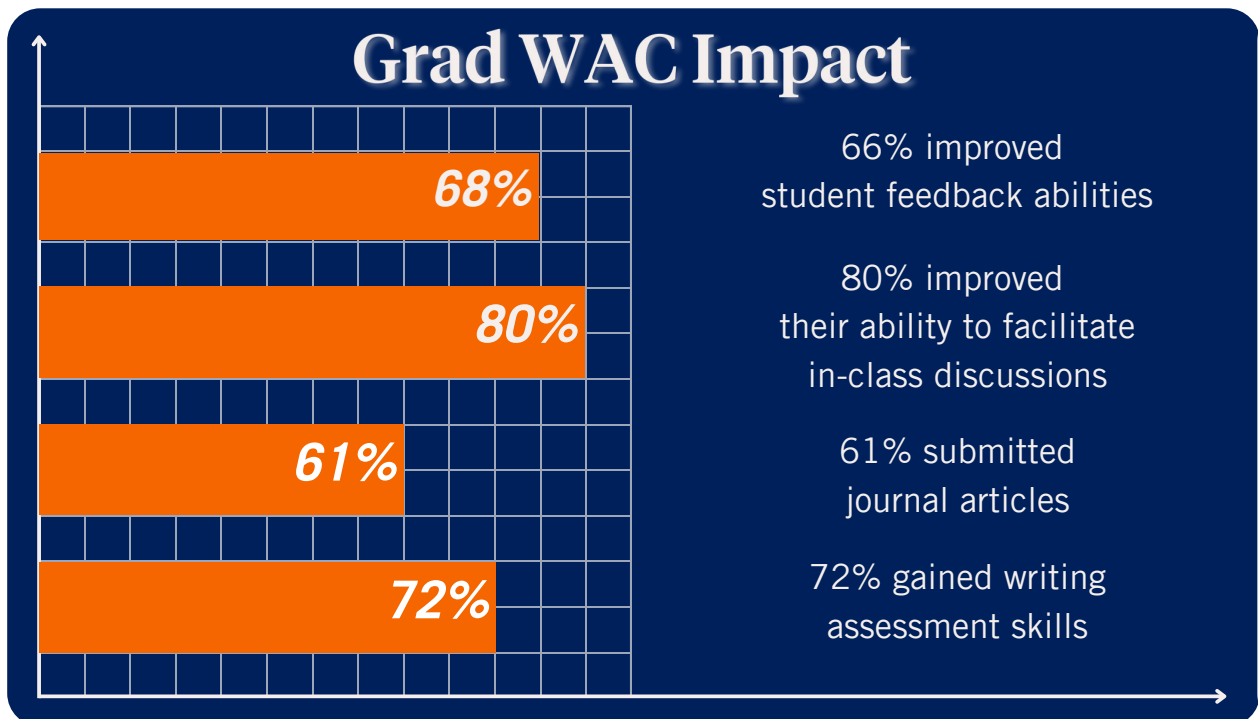

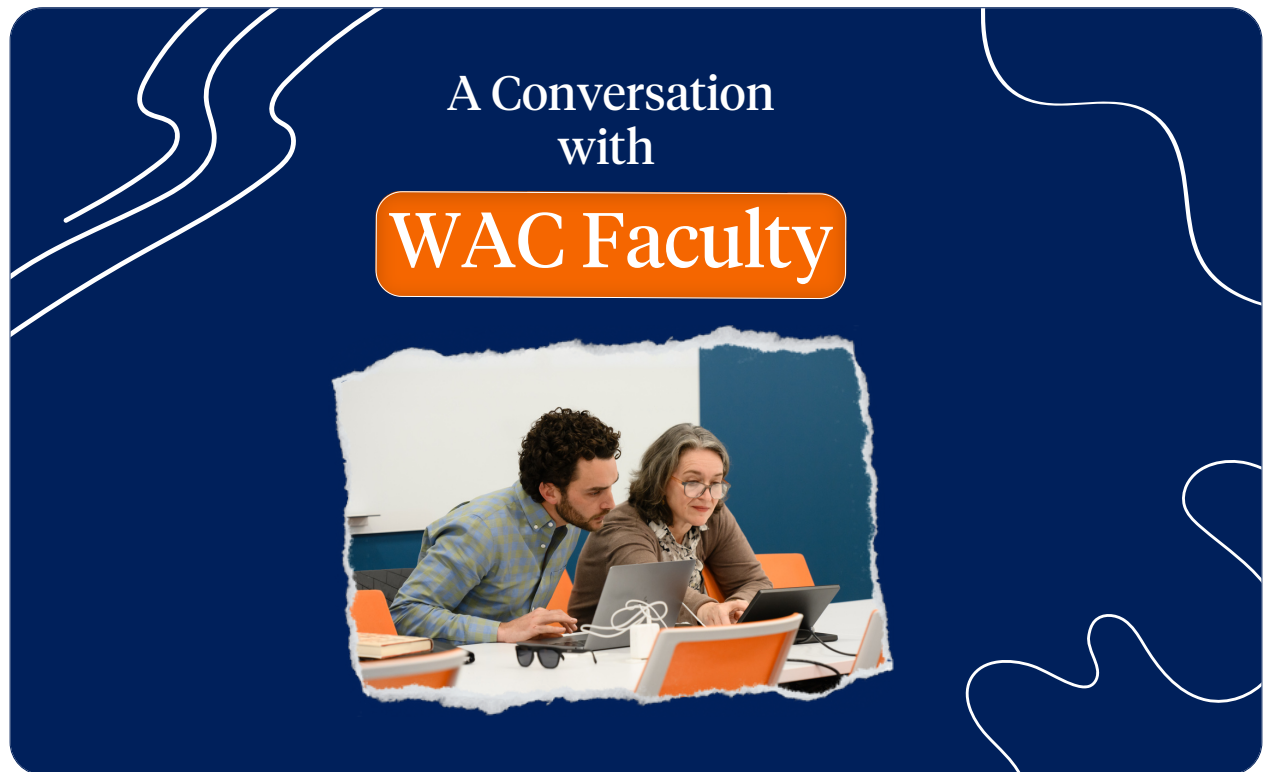

This internship has taught me how to communicate professionally with clients and develop my skills in design. I have more confidence in the workplace, and my resume has expanded significantly.

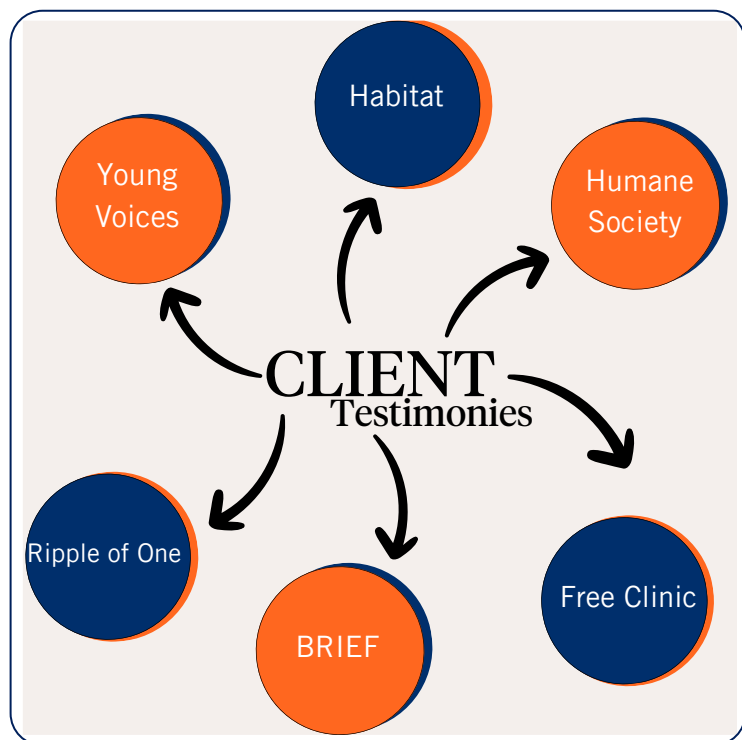
